

Join us for a tour of the Crawford Creek Levels-of-Growing-Stock (LOGS) Study Site, hosted by the Southern Blues Partners. Established in 1967, the Crawford Creek LOGS site is one of several across the Western U.S., to examine the effects of a range of forest stand densities on the long-term growth and development of ponderosa pine. Learn how forest density influences tree growth, forest health, fire resilience, plant diversity, and wildlife habitat. Meet with professionals, landowners, and contractors, and enjoy a great day in the woods.

Tour will include several stops within the Malheur National Forest and will require moderate hiking along rocked and dirt roads, forested areas, and other uneven terrain.
